

LATE BREAKING CASE -

In *Town of Calais v. County Road Commissioners* the Vermont Supreme Court issued an important ruling for municipalities. The ruling clarifies that municipalities are not obligated to maintain Class 4 roads if a town policy clearly provides that Class 4 roads will not be maintained.
