

Each year, as municipal budgets grow and sources of revenue become more diverse, the

task of auditing municipal financial records becomes more difficult. Current Vermont law

doesn't require locally elected auditors to have any education or experience in

bookkeeping or accounting. This training will provide an overview of legal requirements

of the annual elected auditors' report as well as information to help elected auditors fulfill

their responsibilities under Vermont law.
