## Application for VLCT Seat on Downtown Development Board

Legislation provides for a Downtown Development Board of thirteen members, three of whom are local officials, and one of them is appointed by VLCT. The VLCT seat is vacant at this time. The Board meets every fourth Monday of the month at the Agency of Commerce and Community Development in Montpelier Vermont.

This state-level board administers the downtown Development Act to support the preservation and enhancement of Vermont's landscape of compact centers surrounded by rural land. It approves municipal applications for designated centers. Residential development is targeted to designated areas, particularly in legislation currently under consideration.
