Will there be assistance for towns to repair public infrastructure?



Yes, after Vermont receives a Presidential Major Disaster Declaration. Local governments in impacted counties will be eligible for 75% reimbursement for repairs to roads, bridges, and other infrastructure; local cost share will be 25%. The State of Vermont may contribute towards the local cost share of 25% using the <a href="Emergency Relief Assistance Fund (ERAF)">Emergency Relief Assistance Fund (ERAF)</a>. State contribution amounts are based on a municipality taking specific steps to reduce flood damage.
