VLCT Municipal Golf Outing Raises \$7,000 for Scholarship Fund



The 2025 Vermont Local Officials Golf Outing raised \$7,000 for the <u>VLCT Municipal</u> <u>Service Scholarship</u> Fund – the equivalent of more than three scholarships to encourage youth to serve in city, town, and village government.

Municipal officials from 13 different cities, towns, and villages competed in Killington at Vermont's only 18-hole municipal golf course, along with sponsors, vendors, and VLCT supporters. The team from Richmond, comprised of Delina Gilroy, Chuck Gilroy, John O'Sullivan, and Mike Barnard, notched an impressive 13 under par to win the tournament. Long-time VLCT Municipal Golf Outing participants "Fore on the Fringe" – led by Tom Horn, the husband of retired VLCT Director of Advocacy Karen Horn – came close with a nine under par.
