*Free listings on indeed are shown in relevant job seeker search results but then fall back in search as new jobs are added over time. Paid job listings are prioritized in relevant search results and retain their optimal visibility for as long as they're sponsored; so they're seen more often by job seekers. To take advantage of the benefits of paid posting, consider placing a monthly cap on pay-per-clicks that fits within your advertising budget. One town has reported excellent results from using a budget of \$10/day (about \$300/month) for sponsored postings.

Note: Vermont Town Careers coordinates with "Handshake," a platform that connects students at local higher education establishments with career opportunities.
