Your municipality has — or should have — contracts to formalize many professional financial arrangements: building or road construction, road maintenance, facility rental, and more. Before any official or employee signs a contract on behalf of your municipality, show due diligence for protecting taxpayers' money by having PACIF Underwriters review the proposed contract to make sure it does not assign unnecessary risk to the municipality. This **risk** review is free for PACIF members and should be in addition to the **legal** review that you obtain from your municipality's lawyer.
