## Spray Finishing Operations in Public Works Facilities

Municipal public works and highway departments are often tempted to perform spray painting of dump bodies, plows, and trucks to inhibit the rust that can easily form due to harsh weather and road salt. Applying paint and other coatings with a spray gun results in broad and smooth coverage, but it can be a significant source of chemical exposure and creates waste that can become a fire hazard in the workplace.
