



Develop a timeline:

- ☐ Determine election date
- ☐Subtract publication & posting requirements
- ☐ Insert meeting dates
- ☐Tell everyone

A vote planned for October 3rd would require:

- Monday, August 14th: Water Board finalize warning language to submit to select board
- Monday, August 21st: Select Board approve warning
- Thursday, August 24th: Date to post warning
- Islander Publication Dates:
 - Wednesday, September 13th (Sept. 11th is submission deadline)
 - Wednesday, September 20th
 - Wednesday, September 27th (6 days before election)
- Monday, October 2nd: Select Board holds informational meeting
