Title 32: Taxation and Finance

Chapter 135: Education Property Tax

(Cite as: 32 V.S.A. § 5402)

§ 5402. Education property tax liability

(c)(2) The Secretary of Education shall determine each municipality's net nonhomestead education tax payment and its net homestead education tax payment to the State based on grand list information received by the Secretary not later than the March 15 prior to the June 1 net payment. Payment shall be accompanied by a return prescribed by the Secretary of Education. Each municipality may retain 0.225 of one percent of the total education tax collected, only upon timely remittance of net payment to the State Treasurer or to the applicable school district or districts. Each municipality may also retain \$15.00 for each late property tax credit claim filed after April 15 and before September 2, as notified by the Department of Taxes, for the cost of issuing a new property tax bill.





(Cite as: 16 V.S.A. § 426)

§ 426. Duties of the town school district treasurer



(b) Within 120 days after the date on which taxes become delinquent, but in no event later than the end of the school year, the treasurer shall deposit the balance of the sum of the gross school tax levy in the school account.

Chapter 011: UNION SCHOOL DISTRICTS

Subchapter 001: GENERAL PROVISIONS

(Cite as: 16 V.S.A. § 703)

§ 703. Application of other laws and articles of agreement

(a) Other education laws. The provisions of this chapter are intended to be in addition to the general provisions of law pertaining to schools, school districts, and supervisory unions. General provisions of law shall apply to union school districts unless inconsistent with or otherwise provided in this chapter.





§ 5402. Education property tax liability



(c)(1) The treasurer of each municipality shall by December 1 of the year in which the tax is levied and on June 1 of the following year pay to the State Treasurer for deposit in the Education Fund one-half of the municipality's statewide nonhomestead tax and one-half of the municipality's homestead education tax, as determined under subdivision (b)(1) of this section.








Sheldon's Timeline (if under Act 73)


