

UI Modernization Town Hall for VLCT Members

Q: Will we be able to get a copy of the seminar?

A: Yes, a recording of the Town Hall will be available in the near future.

Q: Are hours required for salaried employees?

A: Yes, they will be required in the new system.

Q: Will payroll administrators for employers need their own login? If so, how will they receive access to the employer accounts to do the wage reporting for them?

A: Payroll administrators will need to get their own access to the system. Payroll administrators will be able to request access to their employer's accounts.

Q: Will we continue to make monthly payments?

A: This will depend on how you are set up today. If you currently have an installment plan in place and wish to continue it following go-live, you will be able to set that up in the new system.

Q: Will employees from the current system be transferred to the new system?

A: Yes, we are transferring already filed wage reports and employees will be transferred over as well.

Q: Will our previous Usernames and Passwords still be active or will we need to register a new account to use the new site?

A: You will need to register a new MyVermont account, and then using that, you will be able to gain access to your account in the new system by answering some required key questions.

Q: Re: Tax Calculation screen - What will reimbursable employers see here?

A: If filing timely the amount would be \$0.00. If the report is filed late, the late file penalty will be displayed.

Q: Re: Payment screen - How should this be set up for reimbursers with a TPA such as TALX/Equifax?

A: If you are a reimbursable employer filing as yourself, you can file and proceed without payment. If the TPA is filing on behalf of a reimbursing employer, the TPA will have a payment option in their own login profile. e-Services payment options for both employers as well as TPAs include e-checks as well as credit cards.

Q: Re: Delinquency fees for late or missing reporting - Will these fees also show up in the account balance? And will they be parsed out?

A: You will see your full balance due on the "Summary" page that will include any prior penalties, interest, or contributions owed. When filing a new wage report, the system will only show the late file penalty, interest, or contributions owed that are applicable to the current filing.
